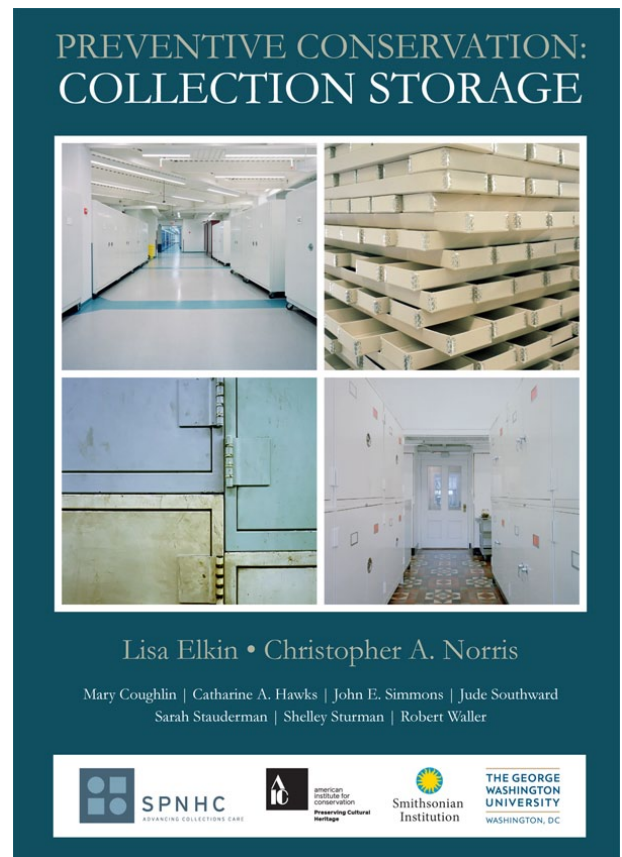

The 36 chapters and 21 Storage at a Glance entries were written by nearly 90 subject area experts reflecting a diverse community of collection care specialists: conservators, conservation scientists, collection managers, archivists, facility managers, architects, engineers, and more. This volume will be the “go-to” reference for preventive conservation as it applies to collection storage for years to come.
