Peter Cole is the author of three books of poems, most recently Things on Which I've Stumbled (New Directions, 2008). Last April, The Poetry of Kabbalah: Mystical Verse from the Jewish Tradition was published by Yale University Press. A book of non-fiction, Sacred Trash: The Lost and Found World of the Cairo Geniza, written with Adina Hoffman, was published in 2011 by Schocken/Nextbook. Cole's other volumes of translations from Hebrew and Arabic include The Dream of the Poem: Hebrew Poetry from Muslim and Christian Spain, 950-1492 (Princeton), Aharon Shabtai's War and Love, Love and War: New & Selected Poems (New Directions), Taha Muhammad Ali's So What: New & Selected Poems 1973-2005 (Copper Canyon), and Hebrew Writers on Writing (Trinity).
