He has produced and directed several award-winning films, and has taught at Bard College, Columbia, the New School for Social Research, New York University, and Princeton. Holman was a director at the Nuyorican Poets Cafe, and founded Mouth Almighty/Mercury Records, the world’s first spoken word poetry label.
